# RULES OF A SPEECH



- 1 Formulas**  
"Honorable chair, distinguished delegates [...]. Thank you."
- 2 Referring to your country**  
Refer to your country by its name, short or long - and to the other with « delegates ».
- 3 Courtesy**  
Do not be too aggressive towards one delegate, you may refer to one speech but don't be offensive.
- 4 Time**  
Respect the allocated time and the signals of the chair. (1 knock = 10" left ; continuous knocks = time's over)

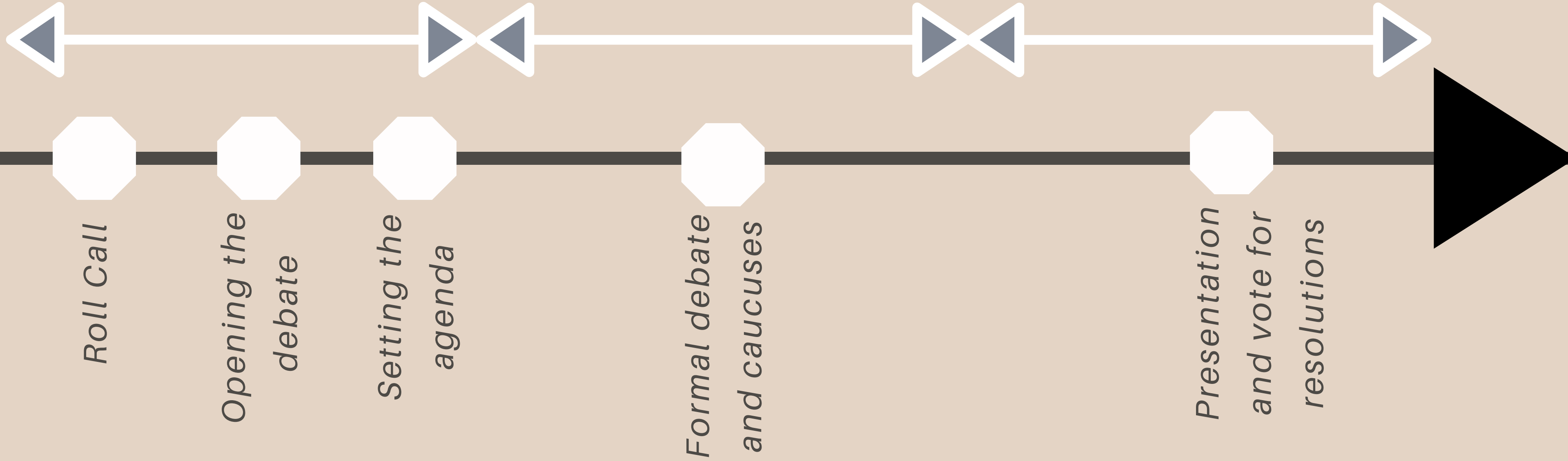

# STRUCTURE OF A RESOLUTION

- 1 Heading**

Committee name, the sponsors, the signatories, and the topic
- 2 Pre-ambulatory clauses**

Issues that the committee wants to resolve on this issue; reasons why the committee is working on this issue; previous international actions on the issue
- 3 Operative clauses**

Solutions that the sponsors of the resolution proposes to resolve the issues

# STEPS IN ORDER TO INTRODUCE YOUR DRAFT RESOLUTION

- 1 Submit your draft resolution**

Must be done during an unmoderated caucus (final one)
- 2 Introducing your draft resolution**

Motion to introduce your draft resolution - 2 minutes-long speech in order to defend your resolution
- 3 Moving to the voting procedure**

Motion for it!







# MAIN STEPS OF THE VOTING PROCEDURE

**1**

## *Change the voting order*

By default, draft resolutions are voted on in order of submission

**2**

## *Round of debate*

Sponsors of the draft resolution come to the podium to answer questions for 15 minutes

**3**

## *Amendments*

Delete, change or add a point. It can be a friendly or unfriendly amendment (1 minute to explain why)

**4**

## *Voting process*

Normal vote OR roll call vote
